For those of you who have yet to experience Polo, here are some aspects explained:

A polo match is divided into 4 to 6 Chukkas of seven minutes at the end of which a bell is rung. Play continues after the bell until the ball goes out to play, hits the side boards, a goal is scored, the whistle is blown for foul, or a further thirty seconds elapses. At this point a horn is sounded.

In the last chukka, the horn is sounded for the end of the match at seven minutes exactly (unless your team are equal, in which case play continues as above. If the teams are still level after 30 seconds, a further chukka can be played with the first team to score the winning the match.

NB Each time a goal is scored the team changes ends.
